COOKIES POLICY

This Cookies Policy explains how Prof. Daphna Joel's lab at Tel Aviv University ("**we**", "**us**", "**our**") uses cookies in the Gender Mosaic website, available at <u>www.gendermosaic.tau.ac.il</u> (the "**Website**"), and how you can control those cookies.

What Are Cookies?

Cookies are text files, comprised of small amount of data, that are saved on your computer or other device (e.g., smartphone, tablet, etc.) when you use internet and visit various websites.

The information that the cookies maintain is read by the website you visit, during the session of your visit to the website (these are called 'session' cookies), and when you return to visit it again (these are called 'persistent' cookies).

We use only necessary and statistics cookies and we do not share the data collected by our cookies with any other entity.

Necessary. Cookies that are strictly necessary for the functioning of the Website. You can choose to block or alert you about these cookies, but if you do so some parts of the Website might not function properly. We use three such cookies:

Two cookies that are necessary for the **proper function of the Gender Mosaic Questionnaire**. One keeps your answers while you are filling out the questionnaire and the other (_GRECAPTCHA) provides the website spam protection. Both cookies will set in **only if you click the Start Questionnaire** button. These cookies do not store any personally identifiable information and they expire after you finish filling out the questionnaire or leave the questionnaire's webpage. These cookies do **not share** the information with any other entity.

The third cookie is necessary for presenting the **Gender Mosaic Questionnaire in** additional languages. The cookie will set in only if you choose a language other than **English** from the drop-down menu on the home page. This cookie does not store any personally identifiable information and it expires after you finish filling out the questionnaire or leave the questionnaire's webpage. This cookie does **not share** the information with any other entity. <u>Statistics</u>. Cookies that help understand how you and other users interact with the Website, by collecting data that does not directly identify you.

We use two Matomo statistics cookies, which **do not share** the information with any other entity. These cookies allow us to count visits and traffic sources so we can measure and improve the performance of our site. They help us know which pages are the most and least popular and see how visitors move around the site. All information these cookies collect is aggregated and therefore anonymous. One cookie (_pk_ses#) expires after one day, the second cookie (_pk_id#) expires after one year.

How Can You Control Cookies?

We use an add-on that enables you to control the use of the statistics cookies - to enable or disable them. However, you cannot disable necessary cookies, as the Website cannot operate without them. Remember, these cookies will set in **only if you start the Gender Mosaic Questionnaire or choose a language other than English.**

By enabling cookies, you give us your consent to collect the data they are intended to collect from you. We do not share the data collected this way with any third party.
